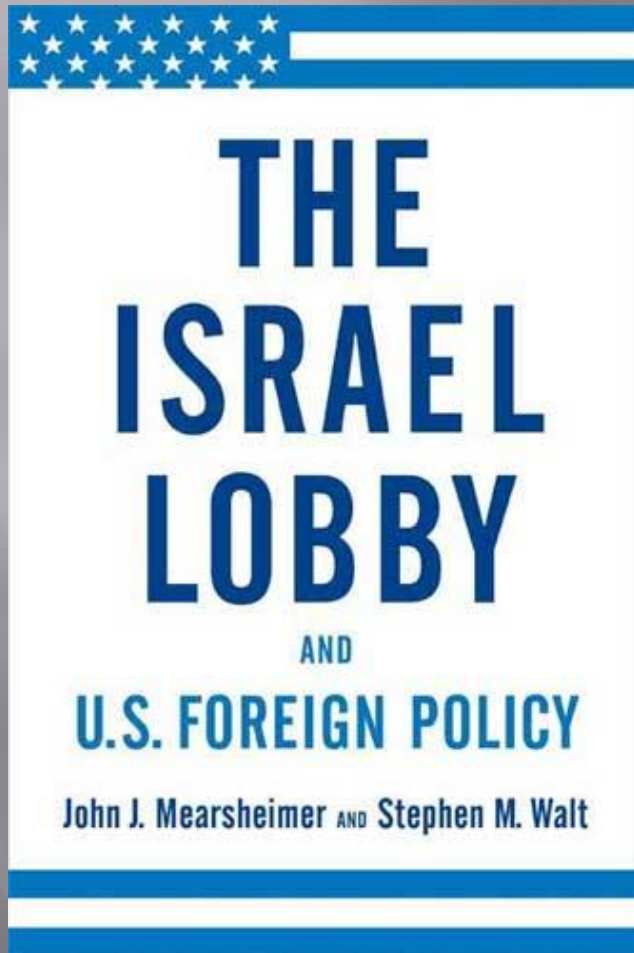
First Considerations

Basic Theses

- ▣ There is an Israel Lobby
- ▣ It represents conservative Israeli political factions
- ▣ Exerts enormous force on US politics and foreign policy
- ▣ These are established, well-known facts, not speculation
- ▣ The lobby harms US, Israel, and world interests

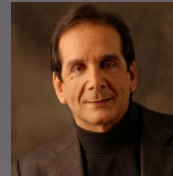

2. Activities of the Lobby

- ▣ Campaign contributions
- ▣ Political pressure
- ▣ Lobbying
- ▣ Propaganda

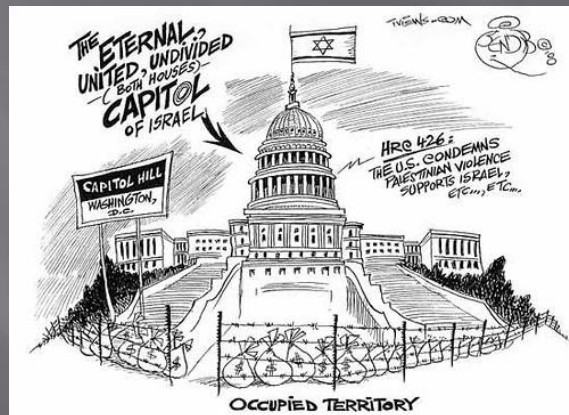
Campaign Contributions

- ▣ AIPAC interviews candidates
- ▣ AIPAC connects approved candidates with extensive private donor network
- ▣ Stealth PACs also make campaign contributions



Political Pressure

- ▣ Letters to public officials
- ▣ Public statements
- ▣ Explicit/implicit threats
- ▣ Mass letter, phone, email campaigns
- ▣ Few member of Congress dare oppose



Lobbying

- ▣ Meetings with officials
- ▣ Background studies
- ▣ Policy recommendations
- ▣ Dinners, awards, social functions, trips



Propaganda

- ▣ Newspaper columns
- ▣ One-sided media presentation: Israel always right
- ▣ Exaggerates strategic importance of Israel to US
- ▣ Overstates moral argument for unconditional support of Israeli policies
- ▣ Attacks every critic as 'anti-Semitic'

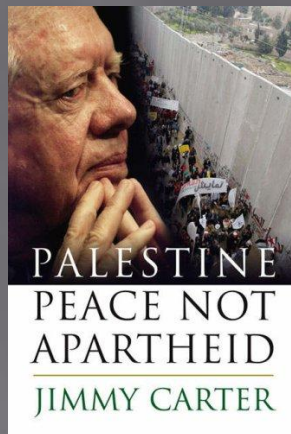


Effects of Lobby

- ▣ Iraq war promoted by Israel Lobby
 - Not by oil companies (war hurts oil profits)
 - Iraq was helping US contain Iran
- ▣ US ignores Israeli civilian attacks in 2006 Lebanon war
- ▣ US tolerates Israeli settlement of West Bank
- ▣ 9/11 attacks expressed Arab anger about US backing of Israeli militarism and Palestinian policies
- ▣ Unwillingness of US to objectively examine Afghan war
- ▣ Iran sanctions and continued tensions
- ▣ No US pressure on Israel to make peace

The Case Against Israeli Rejectionists

- ❑ Israel has no legal right to annex occupied territories
- ❑ 725,000 Palestinians were violently displaced from their homes in 1948
- ❑ West Bank today an apartheid system
- ❑ Palestinians are human beings and have rights!



Rejectionists (ctd)

- ▣ Many Israelis want peace
- ▣ Many support a separate Palestinian state
- ▣ Demagogues promote conflict to control population and consolidate political power



Conclusions

- ▣ George Washington's warning has come true
- ▣ Israeli rejectionists exert enormous influence in American politics and foreign policy
- ▣ The wars in Iraq and Afghanistan, the terrorist threat, and worsening relations with Islamic countries a result
- ▣ This harms Israel as well as the US

What Can Be Done?

- ▣ Call attention to Israel Lobby
- ▣ Scrutinize its influence and suggestions
- ▣ Public campaign financing
- ▣ Demand objective, civil, public debate
